How to fill in the form

When applying for authorisation, the applicant must submit an attestation confirming practical experience. The attestation must be filled in by someone who is entitled to represent the company and who is familiar with the electrical installation work undertaken by the applicant.

It is not just electrical installation work that can be credited as practical experience. Under certain circumstances, the applicant for authorisation can also be credited for other work involving electricity. This means that companies which do not carry out electrical installation work are able issue an attestation confirming practical experience.

1. This attestation concerns

Enter the name and personal ID number of the person covered by the attestation. If the applicant does not have a Swedish personal ID number, enter the date of birth (yyyy-mm-dd).

2. Details of the work

Enter the name and company registration number of the company in which the practical experience was undertaken. Enter the start and end date of the work, and the applicant's role during the period of practical experience. If the work has not finished, check the "Continuing" box.

3. Practical experience

Describe how the practical experience was covered by one of the fields in annex 1, 2 or 3 of ELSÄK-FS 2017:4. Examples of such work include the design, dimensioning, fault location and verification of high-voltage and low-voltage installations or equipment connected to them.

4. Signature

This is where you enter your details as the person entitled to represent the company, and where you sign. You could be the company's compliance officer, person in authority or someone else assigned the task. If the National Electrical Safety Board has questions about the information provided, you may be contacted. It is therefore important for you to be familiar with the scope and content of the practical experience.



Personal Data Processing

When you certify a trainee who applies for authorisation as authorised electrician, the National Electrical Safety Board will process your personal data.

The National Electrical Safety Board processes your personal data for purposes of assessing the application for authorisation for the person whose practical experience you are certifying. The National Electrical Safety Board may contact you to obtain further information about the duration, contents and other circumstances of the practical experience certified by you.

How we use your personal data

The National Electrical Safety Board is a public authority. This means that documents sent to us or prepared by us are filed and archived and become public documents that may be disclosed according to the principle of transparency.

Legal grounds

In order for the National Electrical Safety Board to process personal data, there must be legal grounds for the processing. The legal grounds for the relevant processing are provided in Article 6 1.e of the <u>Data Protection</u> <u>Regulation</u>, namely that processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the National Electrical Safety Board.
